

## Evolve Junior S-Ranked Tournament Series 2025

### Fact Sheet

<b>Format</b>	Players will be split into divisions with a maximum draw-size of 8 as per their most recently updated Match Hub points.  Players will be guaranteed a minimum of 3 matches based upon a full draw, defaults/withdrawals aside.
<b>Dates</b>	25 May, 15 June, 17 August 2025 from 9am
<b>Venue</b>	Khandallah Tennis & Squash Club, 55 Delhi Crescent, Khandallah, Wellington
<b>Eligibility Criteria</b>	This tournament is open to members of clubs affiliated to a Tennis Association recognized by ITF. Males and females 18 years and under as at the last day of the event month with a Match Hub Ranking are eligible.
<b>Entry Deadline</b>	Entries must be received by 11.59pm the Wednesday prior to the tournament. Entries will be limited to the first 32 players.

<b>Player Code</b>	Match Hub player code must be supplied when entering online. If you do not have or do not know your player code, please contact your Club or Association administrator before submitting your entry.
<b>Seeding</b>	Seeding for all events will be based on Match Hub ranking points
<b>Match Format</b>	Weather permitting, matches will be the best of 3 tiebreak sets with the third set being replaced by a super tiebreak (10 points, win by 2). The organiser reserves the right to alter the format as deemed fit.
<b>Withdrawals &amp; Defaults</b>	Tennis NZ Player Code of Behaviour will apply. <b>Warm-up</b>	The warm-up must not exceed 5 minutes
<b>Dress Code</b>	All players shall dress and present themselves in an appropriate manner for tennis. Clean and customarily acceptable tennis attire shall be worn. The organiser has the final decision if the clothing worn is appropriate. Please refer to the Tennis NZ Player Code of Behaviour for further clarification.
