Dates	10 May, 14 June, 16 August 2026 from 9am
Format	<p>For the Graded Singles, 24 players will be split into 3 divisions with a maximum draw-size of 8 as per their most recently updated WTN numbers.</p> <p>For the U10 Green Ball Singles, players will be in a draw-size of 8.</p> <p>Players will be guaranteed a minimum of 3 matches based upon a full draw, defaults/withdrawals aside.</p>
Venue	Khandallah Tennis & Squash Club, 55 Delhi Crescent, Khandallah, Wellington
Eligibility Criteria	<p>This tournament is open to members of clubs affiliated to a Tennis Association recognized by ITF.</p> <p>Males and females 18 years and under as at the last day of the event month are eligible for the Graded Singles.</p> <p>Males and females 10 years and under as at the last day of the event month are eligible for the U10 Green Ball Singles.</p>
Entry Deadline	Online entries must be received by 11.59pm the Wednesday before the tournament. Entries will be limited to the first 24 players for the Graded Singles and the first 8 players for the U10 Green Ball Singles.

Official Ball	Tecnifibre X-One for the Graded Singles and 'green ball' for the U10 Green Ball Singles.

Sign-in	Please sign in 15 minutes before your first scheduled match
Results	The tournament will be run on Tournament Planner and results will be recorded on WTN.
Player Code	A MatchPoint National ID must be supplied when entering online. If you don't have or don't know your player ID, please contact your Association for an ID before entering online.
Seeding	Seeding for all events will be based on WTN points, if known
Match Format	Weather permitting, matches will be the best of 3 tiebreak sets with the third set being replaced by a super tiebreak (10 points, win by 2). The organiser reserves the right to alter the format if circumstances deem it necessary.
Withdrawals & Defaults	If a withdrawal is received by: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - 11.59pm the Wednesday before the tournament, a full refund is provided - before the draw is released, a 50% refund or a full refund if accompanied by a medical certificate - after the draw is released but before the tournament commences, no refund or 50% if accompanied by a medical certificate <p>For defaults and retirements the Tennis NZ Player Code of Behaviour applies https://www.tennis.kiwi/assets/Files-pdf-word-docs-etc/2024-Code-of-Behaviour.pdf</p>
Warm-up	The warm-up must not exceed 5 minutes
Dress Code	All players shall dress and present themselves in an appropriate manner for tennis. Clean and customarily acceptable tennis attire shall be worn. The organiser has the final decision if the clothing worn is appropriate. Please refer to the Tennis NZ Player Code of Behaviour for further clarification.
